

Settlements arrived before RLC(C), Hyderabad in the month of September, 2023

After multiple rounds of discussions, a settlement has been arrived between Contractor's Association and contract workers of NTPC, Ramagundam for wage increase and other allowances on 01.09.2023 before the Regional Labour Commissioner(C), Hyderabad.

The settlement will benefit around 3500 contract workers with a tune of Approx. Rs. 4.5 Crore per year. The settlement was signed with retrospective effect from Aug, 2022 and will remain valid till Aug, 2026.

Other major points covered such as Accidental Insurance upto Rs.17.5 lakhs and Natural Death Insurance upto Rs.5 lakhs over and above statutory compensation. The settlement is a huge gift to the workers before the festive season. Moreover, it's a great achievement for Hyderabad Region.
